But a recent Labor Ministry survey found that one in three Indian graduates is unemployed despite rising education standards. 

How organizations benefit from Certification

Rapidly evolving technology has resulted in higher demand for skilled individuals by industry. The need for qualified and competent manpower is higher than ever before. Organizations consider employee credentials, such as certifications as important factors in the hiring process. Professional certifications bring in a multitude of benefits to organizations:

A) Improved productivity

There is growing evidence that certification improves the bottom line for businesses. A research study conducted by the International Data Corporation, Benefits and Productivity Gains Realized Through IT Certification, cites several examples of how certification benefits corporations in the IT sector:-

- Certified professionals handled 40 percent more support calls per person, per day, than the uncertified staff.
- Companies that advocated certification reported 49 percent less downtime than those that did not.
- The costs of certification were repaid in fewer than nine months by the savings from increased effectiveness in the majority of companies surveyed.

B) Setting industry benchmarks

Certification offers confidence that candidates exhibit a level of competence in the required skill set. Organizations investing in certification process have harvested the fruits of their investments as their qualified manpower are capable of setting higher qualitative benchmarks in the industry. Employees who have earned certifications, either as a part of the specialized training or work experience, have demonstrated a higher level of competence which has helped teams and organizations in establishing higher industry benchmarks, resulting in enhanced reputation for the companies employing them within the industry.

C) Improved staff effectiveness

Candidates value Certification programs highly because they help them to stay relevant and current in the evolving business environment and improve their chances of career advancement within the organisation as they can take up bigger and more complex tasks. Certified employees also increase their teams' credibility and clients exhibit higher confidence while dealing with a team of certified members.

A) Relevance

In a rapidly changing and competitive environment where technology breakthroughs change the rules of the game faster than ever before, staying current and abreast of the latest technology is more important than ever for employees. They look to certification to help them stay relevant to their jobs and skill set.

B) Confidence and personal accomplishment

Although the exact relationship between certification and job performance is difficult to measure, surveys show that earning a credential increases certificants' confidence in critical thinking and professional abilities. The American Board of Nursing Specialties' Value of Certification Survey found a high level of agreement on how certification impacts certificants' perceptions of themselves. In considering several value statements, for example, nurses responded that they "agree" or "strongly agree" that certification:

Enhances professional credibility	95.4%
Enhances feeling of personal accomplishment	98.0%
Enhances personal confidence in clinical abilities	88.2%

That same survey found that nurse managers responded positively to job effectiveness value statements in "agreeing" or "strongly agreeing" that certification:

Validates specialized knowledge	97.9%
Indicates attainment of a practice standard	94.4%
Provides evidence of accountability	87.4%

A survey by Pearson VUE and Firebrand found that 75 percent of 1,300 respondents who had recently trained and received an IT certification did so to improve their reputation among peers, improve confidence and to work on more complex tasks.

C) Career advancement

Certification helps managers identify employees with the latest skills, knowledge and drive to move into leadership positions. This is especially true in industries such as IT and medicine, which face rapid and dramatic change.

Oracle University compared the average salary of individuals who hold Oracle certifications vs those who do not and found measurable differences. Globally, Oracle Certified Professionals earn 13.7 percent more than their non-certified colleagues.

According to the Global Knowledge and Tech Republic 2012 IT Skills and Salary Report, more than half of the respondents said employers support and recognize the value certifications provide.

The Institute for Credentialing Excellence describes the five characteristics that make a certification valuable:

- Built on a demonstrated market need: There must be perceived value in distinguishing those who have proven competency and those who have not.
- Objectivity: Qualified and independent subject matter experts, third-party endorsement and autonomy in governing the certification program are essential in developing and maintaining a valid and legally defensible credential.
- Rigour: A certification that requires little effort or knowledge
 or one that everyone can earn is typically of a lower value
 than the one that demands great effort. A rigorous regimen of
 training and assessment is essential to a successful certification
 programme, which by its nature is often perceived as a
 competitive advantage.
- Emphasis on ethics: Ethical conduct covers a broad range of topics, from protecting the certification exam from cheaters to ensuring the ethical practice of the profession.
- Re-certification: Because all industries and organisations grow and change, professionals that serve them must do the same.
