

Identification (ID) Requirements:

- The first and last name that the candidate uses to register must match exactly the first and last name on the ID that is presented on test day.
- Candidate is required to present one *original* (no photo copies), *valid* (unexpired) form of *government issued ID* that includes their name, recent recognizable photograph, signature (including embedded), and full date of birth from the candidate’s country of citizenship.

Additional Allowances:

- Expired forms of ID are not acceptable; unless accompanied by valid renewal papers. Renewal papers do not make an expired International Travel Passport valid.
- Candidates testing at a military center **MUST** present their military ID.
- Candidate testing within **Bangladesh, Ghana, Hong Kong, India, Japan, Nepal, Nigeria, Pakistan, Singapore South Korea, or Taiwan** (regardless of Country of Citizenship), must present a passport.
- **Chinese** citizens testing in **China** (excluding Hong Kong SAR or Macau SAR) can present a passport or Chinese National ID Card.
- **Chinese** citizens of Macau SAR or Hong Kong SAR can present a passport or Hong Kong special administrative document of identity for Visa purposes.
- Residents of Mainland **China** testing in **Taiwan** can present a passport or entry permit (Ru Tai Zheng).
- **Syrian** Candidates must provide proof of residency outside of Syria.
- **Canadian** health cards are NOT acceptable.
- **European Union** candidates testing within the EU zone, may also provide a valid, unexpired EU card.
- **Schengen zone** candidates testing within the Schengen zone, may provide one of the ID types listed in the **Testing inside your country of citizenship** section above.
- Candidate exceptions to the ID policy must be pre-approved by the Pearson VUE customer service center at least three business days before the scheduled exam appointment.
