Task #1 Infection Control & Safety

ADMINISTRATIVE USE ONLY

- Arrives with disinfected implements in sealed containers and clean supplies 1
- The First Aid Kit is packed with necessary supplies as defined in the Practical Skills Supply List in the Candidate Handbook 2
- Sanitizes own hands at the beginning of skills 3
- Sanitizes own hands if hands become unsanitary 4
- Sanitizes the work area at beginning of skills 5
- Sanitizes the work area if area becomes unsanitary 6
- Follows standards of Universal Precautions to clean blood and bodily fluids 7
- Disinfects implements if the implements become unsanitary during tasks 8
- Places disposable materials in the trash after each use 9
- Places used implements in a container separate from disinfected implements 10

Task #2 Basic Facial (15 minutes)

ADMINISTRATIVE USE ONLY

- Drapes the model to protect clothing and hair 1
- Applies cleanser, avoiding the eye area 2
- Spreads cleanser over the entire face using upward motions 3
- Removes cleanser 4
- Applies massage product, avoiding the eye area 5
- Performs effleurage, petrissage, and tapotement a minimum of one time each on entire face 6

- Maintains hand contact with the model's skin throughout manipulations 7
- Uses the cushions of fingertips or palms for facial manipulations 8
- Demonstrates effleurage manipulations a minimum of one time on entire face 9
- Demonstrates petrissage manipulations a minimum of one time on entire face 10
- Demonstrates tapotement manipulations a minimum of one time on entire face 11
- Removes massage product 12
- Applies toner or astringent to skin 13
- Applies moisturizer 14
- Prevents cross-contamination 15

Task #3 Makeup Application (15 minutes)

ADMINISTRATIVE USE ONLY

- Applies and blends concealer evenly 1
- Applies and blends foundation evenly 2
- Applies and blends eye shadow 3
- Sanitizes eyebrow pencil by sharpening 4
- Applies eyebrow pencil 5
- Applies mascara 6
- Applies and blends blush 7
- Applies lipcolor 8
- Uses disposable applicators 9
- Avoids double-dipping 10
- Prevents cross-contamination 11

Task #4 Basic Manicure - One Hand Only (12 minutes)

ADMINISTRATIVE USE ONLY

- Sanitizes the model's hand 1
- Removes polish (if model's nails are polished) 2
- Places a bowl of water on the work area 3
- Uses a nail file or emery board to shape the nail from corner to center 4
- Soaks fingertips in bowl 5
- Brushes the nail with a manicure brush in a downward movement 6

- Applies cuticle remover with an applicator 7
- Uses a disinfected cuticle pusher or cotton-tipped orangewood stick to push back cuticles 8
- Without cutting, demonstrates the ability to trim excess cuticle using nipper 9
- Cleans under the free edge 10
- Dries the model's hands and nails 11

Task #5 Polish Application - One Hand Only (10 minutes)

ADMINISTRATIVE USE ONLY

- Removes traces of oil with alcohol or polish remover 1
- Applies base coat to the nails 2
- Applies two coats of dark-colored polish from the base to the free edge 3
- Applies top coat to the nails 4
- Removes excess polish on the skin 5

Task #6 Hair Color - Retouch (15 minutes)

ADMINISTRATIVE USE ONLY

- Drapes for chemical service using chemical service cape and 2 terry cloth towels 1
- Sections the hair into 4 quadrants 2
- Partings are straight 3
- Wears disposable gloves during application 4
- Using a bottle, or brush and bowl, applies color at the scalp, completely covering 1/2" to 1" of regrowth 5
- Cross-checks the section to ensure complete coverage 6
- Avoids overlapping color onto previously colored hair 7

Task #7 Hair Color - Highlighting with Foils (10 minutes)

ADMINISTRATIVE USE ONLY

- Drapes for chemical service using chemical service cape and 2 terry cloth towels 1
- Wears disposable gloves during application 2
- Completes 3 foils 3
- Demonstrates clean partings 4
- Using a brush and a bowl, applies color evenly to the hair strand, being careful not to extend to scalp area 5

Task #8 Chemical Relaxer – Virgin (15 minutes) Yes No

ADMINISTRATIVE USE ONLY

- 1 Drapes for chemical service using chemical service cape and 2 terry cloth towels..... 1
- 2 Applies base cream around the quadrant..... 2
- 3 Wears disposable gloves during application of relaxer..... 3
- 4 Applies relaxer approximately 1/4" to 1/2" from the scalp up to 1/2" from the ends..... 4
- 5 Applies relaxer to scalp area and ends..... 5
- 6 Smooths the hair with back of non-metal comb, fingers, or applicator brush..... 6
- 7 Cross-checks the section to ensure complete coverage..... 7
- 8 Keeps unprotected area free from product..... 8

Task #9 Chemical Relaxer – Retouch (10 minutes) Yes No

ADMINISTRATIVE USE ONLY

- 1 Drapes for chemical service using chemical service cape and 2 terry cloth towels..... 1
- 2 Applies base cream around the quadrant..... 2
- 3 Wears disposable gloves during the application of relaxer..... 3
- 4 Applies relaxer to regrowth..... 4
- 5 Smooths the hair with back of non-metal comb, fingers, or applicator brush..... 5
- 6 Cross-checks the section to ensure complete coverage..... 6
- 7 Keeps the mid-shaft and ends free from relaxer..... 7
- 8 Keeps the unprotected area free from relaxer..... 8

Task #10 Braiding (Overhand/Underhand) (10 minutes) Yes No

ADMINISTRATIVE USE ONLY

- 1 Drapes the model..... 1
- 2 Sections the hair..... 2
- 3 Braids one entire quadrant to the end of the hair..... 3
- 4 Sections are clean..... 4

Task #11 Permanent Wave (20 minutes) Yes No

ADMINISTRATIVE USE ONLY

- 1 Drapes the model for chemical service..... 1
- 2 Sections the hair into 9 sections..... 2
- 3 Section width correlates with the length of the rod..... 3
- 4 Sub-section correlates with the diameter of the rod size.... 4
- 5 Partings are straight and clean..... 5
- 6 Wraps three rods in the crown section..... 6

- 7 Winds the hair around the rods evenly and smoothly..... 7
- 8 Fastens the band along the top of the rod not twisted or touching the scalp..... 8
- 9 Applies protective cream or cotton around the wrapped section..... 9
- 10 Wears disposable gloves during perm solution application..... 10
- 11 Thoroughly saturates each rod..... 11
- 12 Demonstrates a test curl..... 12
- 13 Finishes without fishhooks..... 13

Task #12 Finger Wave and Pin Curls (12 minutes) Yes No

ADMINISTRATIVE USE ONLY

- 1 Drapes the model with a shampoo cape and 2 terry cloth towels..... 1
- 2 Directs the hair into C-shape..... 2
- 3 With hand flat against head, places index finger above position for the ridge..... 3
- 4 Inserts the comb directly under index finger..... 4
- 5 Directs the hair..... 5
- 6 Flattens the comb against the head to fix the ridge in place..... 6
- 7 Rolls hand on top of ridge to fix ridge in place..... 7
- 8 Directs the hair in the opposite direction..... 8
- 9 Forms three ridges..... 9
- 10 Finishes with a minimum of two 'c' shaped pin curls..... 10

Task #13 Shampoo (10 minutes) Yes No

ADMINISTRATIVE USE ONLY

- 1 Drapes the model with a shampoo cape and 2 terry cloth towels..... 1
- 2 Places the model's cape over the back of the chair..... 2
- 3 Positions the head in shampoo bowl for comfort and safety..... 3
- 4 Tests the water temperature prior to saturating the model's hair..... 4
- 5 Wets the hair thoroughly..... 5
- 6 Protects the facial area and ears from water..... 6
- 7 Applies shampoo to the hair..... 7
- 8 Uses the cushions of fingertips to shampoo the entire scalp and hair..... 8
- 9 Lifts the head and shampoos the nape area using a vertical motion..... 9
- 10 Rinses the hair thoroughly..... 10
- 11 Dries the hair with a towel..... 11

Task #14 Basic Layered Haircut – (90 Degree) (20 minutes) Yes No

ADMINISTRATIVE USE ONLY

- 1 Drapes the model with a neckstrip or towel and cutting or styling cape..... 1
- 2 Sections the hair in a MINIMUM of 4 sections..... 2
- 3 Uses clips to hold the hair in place..... 3
- 4 Holds the comb and cutting tool in hand(s) throughout the haircut..... 4
- 5 Establishes and follows a guideline..... 5
- 6 Removes a minimum of 1/4" of hair..... 6
- 7 Completes a 90 degree layered haircut..... 7
- 8 Uses the cutting tools safely..... 8
- 9 Cleans or sweeps the area when finished..... 9

Task #15 Thermal Styling – Blow Drying (20 minutes) Yes No

ADMINISTRATIVE USE ONLY

- 1 Drapes the model with a neckstrip or towel and styling cape..... 1
- 2 Sections the hair..... 2
- 3 Uses clips to hold the hair in place..... 3
- 4 Directs the nozzle of the hair dryer away from the model's scalp..... 4
- 5 Uses a brush to control the hair during blow dry..... 5
- 6 After completing blow dry, the hair is completely dry..... 6

Task #16 Thermal Styling – Curling Iron (10 minutes) Yes No

ADMINISTRATIVE USE ONLY

- 1 Drapes the model with a neckstrip or towel and styling cape..... 1
- 2 Checks the temperature of curling iron with a white paper or a towel..... 2
- 3 Sub-sections are in relation to diameter of curling iron..... 3
- 4 Demonstrates 2 on-base curls in the crown section..... 4
- 5 Demonstrates 2 off-base curls on the side of the model's head..... 5
- 6 Places a comb between the iron and scalp to prevent burns..... 6
- 7 Partings for sub-section are straight and consistent in size... 7
- 8 Hair is free of fishhooks..... 8
- 9 Hair is free of ridges..... 9
- 10 Sanitizes the work area..... 10
